Overview of Position:

Manufacturing Maintenance Solutions (MMS) looking for Industrial Millwrights. Millwrights work out of the main office in Pekin, IL and are assigned to customer locations. Customer sites may vary day to day, depending on customer requirements and service needs. Millwrights will perform the installation, assembly, dismantling, repair, and maintenance of machinery, transferring equipment with full precision and according to layout plans, blueprints, and schematics.

Working conditions:

- Protective eyewear and hearing protection are required in shop areas at all times.
- Temperatures may range from 40-120 degrees, depending on the area of the plant an individual may be working in.
- Job duties may require outside work at any time during the year.
- Job duties may require working from man lifts, ladders, or platforms above floor level. Job duties may involve the use of solvents, oils, grease, etc. Appropriate personal protective equipment is required.

Required Skills & Qualities:

- Minimum 3 years' experience as a millwright or industrial maintenance technician.
- Proficient in maintaining/troubleshooting machinery and equipment.
- Proficient in installation of new machinery/equipment.
- Read, interpret, and follow blueprints and detailed drawings.
- Insert shims, adjust tension on nuts and bolts, or position parts, using hand tools and measuring instruments, to set specified clearances between moving and stationary parts.
- Ability to use hand tools, small powered equipment (saws, drills, etc.), and other shop equipment.
- Analyze current conditions on a consistent basis to make strategic changes, adjustments, and major overhauls as needed.
- Replace defective parts of machine or adjust clearances and alignment of moving parts.
- Adjust equipment to ensure optimal performance.
- Level bedplate and establish centerline, using straightedge, levels, and transit.
- Knowledge of welding, fabrication of parts or components.
- Knowledge of motors, shaft & belt driven systems.
- Knowledge of hydraulics and pneumatics.

Required Skills & Qualities (cont.)

- Knowledge of hydraulics and pneumatics.
- Knowledge of pipefitting and plumbing.
- Knowledge of rigging & moving machines and selecting the proper tools and techniques to safely complete the job.
- Align machines using hoists, jacks, hand tools, squares, and rules.
- Use of various types of measuring tools.
- Repair / replace gaskets, seals, hydraulic hoses, packing, bearings, gears, chains, and belts.
- Verification of proper machine function after installation or repairs.
- Operate a forklift, man lift and carry deck crane.
- Pay strong attention to detail.
- Communicate with customers & team members.
- Ability to carry out verbal and written instructions
- Ability to prepare simple written reports
- Ability to analyze information and to make an informed decision based on that information
- Ability to use and understand maintenance CMMS systems is a plus.
- Ability to work with a minimum of supervision in a team environment. Will work alone or as a member of a work crew, depending on the work assignment
- Strict adherence to safety regulations and policies
- Ability to handle physical workload
- Must have a valid state driver's license, vehicle insurance and dependable vehicle
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident of U.S.

Responsibilities:
